Some of you might remember Morrison Academy Kaohsiung's Christmas project last year, of the kids in Cambodia not having clean water. We raised money for clean water for them, and we made up to 600,000 NT. That's about \$20,000 US dollars!! That means we gave clean water to 12,000 children and eleven schools! We thank everyone who was able to raise money for the poor children in Cambodia.

This year, we are doing another Christmas project! We are helping Madagascar with planting trees. Madagascar doesn't have a lot of trees right now. A lot of them are being cut down! So we are asking you guys to help us to raise to 300,000 NT or more (That's about \$10,000 US dollars!). **Eden Reforestation Projects** is asking us for 10 cents a tree. Our school is doing a Coffee & Desert House on Friday, December 2nd. There's a variety show, too. A variety show is where kids from Kindergarten to 9th grade will go on stage and sing, dance, do a skit, etc., while the visitors eat and drink.
