On The Mend

Thank you for your intercession on my behalf! I wanted to let you know how important those prayers were (and are!) and how marvelously God answered in response.

As you know, I began experiencing upper back pain, similar to that of 2006, in September of last year. When it began to shoot down my right arm, I made an appointment with my neurosurgeon here in Chile. MRIs confirmed that I had another herniated disc. I began to lose feeling in my limbs and experienced constant tingling and burning sensations.

We went ahead with our plan to spend Christmas and New Years in Indianapolis. Not having a US referral and with the holidays upon us, it was difficult to impossible to get a second opinion or any kind of appointment at all. My symptoms began to escalate out of control.

We cried out to the Lord for a knowledgeable contact. God answered almost immediately! A local Free Methodist doctor referred my case to the Indiana Spine Group, where Dr. Justin Miller graciously worked me into his schedule.

A few days later I was being operated on at Hendricks Regional Hospital. My spinal cord was in grave danger but nothing was impossible for God! I praise Him for the excellent care He provided in my time of need. The Anterior Cervical Spinal Fusion went very well, with no complications. God knew ahead of time that Leo and I would need assistance with the children during recovery. And there we were! In the home of my own

parents.

We have since returned to Chile, where recuperation continues to go well. I will be able to travel again from May onward. In the meantime, we are back in full swing and enjoying serving Jesus with renewed appreciation for health and life and all things of eternal value.
