Before Monday:

<u>Attendance</u> – Because of the limitations of the Special Sitting, only <u>voting</u> delegates will be present in the meeting other than those running the meeting. Those running the meeting (for example: IT Support, Administrative Support, and Interpreters who are not also delegates) will not have the ability to cast a vote.
